

CD/RES. 07 (85-R/10)

CREATION OF A WORK GROUP TO DRAFT THE IIN ACTION PLAN FOR 2011-2015

(Adopted at the fourth plenary session, held on September 24, 2010)

THE DIRECTING COUNCIL,

CONSIDERING:

That the IIN Action Plan for 2007-2011 is in its final stages, and consequently it is necessary to define strategic guidelines conducive to the creation of the Action Plan for 2011-2015;

That for the aforementioned plan to contemplate with a due degree of representation the various sub-regions in the Americas, it is necessary to put together a work group to accompany the IIN Directorate General in the drafting of the aforementioned Action Plan;

That at the third plenary session of the 85th Regular Meeting of the IIN Directing Council, the delegations reached a consensus on the need to incorporate other topics to those already included in the current Action Plan, in keeping with the evolution of the public policies regarding children and adolescents developed in each of the countries and the operational and management requirements of the IIN,

RESOLVES:

1. To create a Work Group made up of the President, Vice President, Director General and main representatives before the Directing Council of Brazil, Canada, Costa Rica, Ecuador, Haiti and Trinidad and Tobago, representatives of the various sub-regions for this purpose.
2. To establish as a time frame for the Work Group to present the strategic guidelines on which the 2011-2015 Action Plan should be based, on December 31st, 2010.
3. That this Work Group, while determining the course of action should consider to include, among others, the following topics that, having been presented by several Delegations of the Member States as draft resolutions, should - because of their importance - become a part of the Action Plan.

- Children and Adolescents from native peoples and Afro-descendants;
- Situations of violence that affect Children and Adolescents;
- The family as the central space in the development of Children and Adolescents;
- Trafficking and exploitation of Children and Adolescents for purpose of sexual and or labor exploitation;
- Children and adolescents and media and systems of communication.

4. Additionally, the Work Group shall take into account the following topics:

- Children and adolescents as victims of natural disasters;
- Early Childhood;
- Non accompanied Migrant Children;
- Foster Care;
- Juvenile Justice

5. The Work Group created will have as one of its objectives proposing innovative operational management mechanisms and methodologies for the IIN and its Directing Council.

6. The Members States shall have until October 31, 2010, to refer to the IIN General Directorate other guiding topics for the Work Group.
