APPROVAL OF ACTION PLAN 2023-2027

(Approved in the Fourth Plenary Session, held on October 26, 2023)

THE DIRECTING COUNCIL,

HAVING SEEN:

The 2023-2027 Action Plan submitted by the Director General of the Inter-American Children's Institute (IIN) in compliance with paragraph d) of Article 26 of the Institute's Statutes;

CONSIDERING:

That the primary purpose of the IIN, as a specialized agency of the OAS with technical autonomy in the planning and realization of its objectives, is to cooperate with the Governments of the Member States in promoting the development of comprehensive proposals in the normative and programmatic dimensions, with human rights, equity and integral protection approaches, which guarantees the promotion, protection and exercise of the human rights of children in the region;

That the Action Plan should provide continuity, within the framework of the strategic vision of the OAS, the processes that it develops in compliance with the mandates received by the corresponding organs of the OAS and the IIN; Taking into account the needs and specificities of all the sub-regions of the Americas;

RESOLVES:

1. Approve the 2023-2027 Action Plan submitted by the Director General of the IIN.

3. Approve the programmed activities for 2024, which were presented and reviewed, in the framework of this new Action Plan, by the Directing Council.

5. Entrust the office of the Director General of the IIN to widely disseminate the approved Action Plan, ensuring that governmental, international organizations, and other stakeholders become aware of it to facilitate the generation of coordinated actions.
